Instrumental "with"

The predominant way to express instrumentality in biblical Hebrew seems to be with the preposition 3. I found one case that appears to be an 'adverbial accusative' (see Psalm 39:1 below).

Genesis 38:14

וַתִּכַס בַּצְעִיף

she covered herself with a veil

Exodus 21:18

וָהַכָּה־אִישׁ אֵת־רֵעֵּהוּ בָּאֵבֶן אָוֹ בְאָגְרָף

and a man strikes his neighbour with a stone or with a fist

Exodus 34:20

וּפֵטֶר חַמוֹר תִּפְדֵה בְּשֵּׂה

the firstling of a donkey you shall redeem with a lamb

Numbers 4:11

וְבִסְּוּ אֹתוֹ בְּמִבְמֵה עְוֹר תְּחַשׁ

and they shall cover it with the skin of a badger

Numbers 15:30

וְהַנֶּפֶשׁ אֲשֶׁר־תַּעֲשֶׂהוּ בְּיֵד רְלְה

the person who acts with a high hand

Numbers 20:20

וַיֵּצֵא אֱדוֹם לִקְרָאתוֹ בְּעָם כְּבֵד וּבְיֶד חֲזָקָה:

Edom came out to meet him with a large army and with a strong hand

1 Samuel 17:45

וַיָּאמֶר דְּוִד אֶל־הַפְּלִשְׁתִּׁי אַתָּה בָּא אֵלֵי בְּחֶרֶב וּבַחֲנִית וּבְּכִידְוֹן

David said to the Philistine, you come to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin

1 Samuel 28:12

וַתִּזִעָק בְּקוֹל גָּדָוֹל

she cried out with a loud voice

Instrumental "with"

1 Kings 20:38

he disguised himself with a bandage over his eyes

1 Chronicles 11:23

he went down to him with a staff

2 Chronicles 25:2

he did what was right in the eyes of the LORD, yet not with a whole heart.

Psalm 2:9

You shall break them with a rod of iron

Psalm 39:1

I will guard my mouth with a muzzle

Psalm 78:14

In the daytime he led them with a cloud, and all the night with a fiery light.

Jeremiah 15:7

I have winnowed them with a winnowing fork

Jeremiah 36:23

he would cut it off with the razor of a scribe

Instrumental "with" Habakkuk 1:15

בֻּלֹּה בְּחַבְּה הֵעֲלָה

each of them with a hook he brings up

Malachi 3:9

בַּמְאֵרָה אַתֶּם גֵאָרִים

with a curse you are cursed
